1. Praise God! For it is good to sing to our God; for [His] praise is pleasant, befitting.

ב בּוֹנֵה יְרוּשָׁלַם ד' נִדְחֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל יִכְנֹס:

2. The builder of Jerusalem is Adoniye; the banished ones of Israel He will gather.

ג הַרְוִיפָא לְשִׁבּוּרֵי לֵב וּמְחַבֵּשׁ לְעַצְבוֹתָם:

3. [He is] the Healer of the broken-hearted and [also] binds up their wounds.

ד מוֹנֵה מִסְפָּר לַכּוֹכְבִים לְכֹלָם שְׁמוֹת יִקְרָא:

4. He fixes the number of stars; He calls all of them by Names.

ה גָּדוֹל אֲדוֹנֵינוּ וְרַב־כֹּחַ לְתַבּוּנָתוֹ אֵין מִסְפָּר:

5. Great is our Master and abundant in power; His understanding is beyond reckoning.

ו מְעוֹדֵד עֲנוּיִם ד' מְשַׁפִּיל רְשָׁעִים עַד־אָרֶץ:

6. Adoniye causes the humble to stand firm; He casts down the wicked to the ground.

ז עֲנֵנו לַד' בְּתוֹדָה זָמְרוּ לֵאלֹהֵינוּ בְּכִנּוֹר:

7. Cry out to Adoniye in thanksgiving; sing to our God with the harp.

8. [The One] Who covers the heavens with clouds, Who prepares rain for the earth; Who causes grass to grow upon the hills.

ט נוֹתֵן לַבְּהֵמָה לַחֵמָה לַבְּנֵי עֹלֵב אֲשֶׁר יִקְרְאוּ:

9. Who gives the animal its fodder; [also] to the young ravens which call.

י לֹא בְּגִבּוֹרַת הַסּוּס יִחַפֵּץ לֹא-בְשׁוֹקֵי הָאִישׁ יִרְצֶה:

10. Not the power of the horse does He desire, nor the thighs of man does He want.

יא רוֹצֶה ד' אֶת-יִרְאַיוֹ אֶת-הַמִּלְחָלִים לְחַסְדּוֹ:

11. Adoniye wants those who fear Him, those who hope for His kindness.

יב שְׁבַחֵי יְרוּשָׁלַם אֶת-ד' הַלְלֵי אֱלֹהֵיךָ צִיּוֹן:

12. Jerusalem, praise Adoniye; Zion, extol your God.

יג כִּי-חֲזַק בְּרִיחֵי שַׁעְרֶיךָ בָּרַךְ בְּנֵיךָ בְּקִרְבֶּךָ:

13. For He has fortified the bars of your gates; He has blessed your children in your midst.

יד השם גבולך שלום חלב חטים ישביעך:

14. He established peace at your border; with prime wheat He satisfies you.

טו השלח אמרתו ארץ עד-מהרה לרוץ דברו:

15. He dispatches His command earthward; His word races swiftly.

טז הנתן שלג כצמר כפור כאפר יפזר:

16. He provides snow like fleece, He scatters frost like ashes.

יז משליך קרחו כפתים לפני קרתו מי יעמד:

17. He hurls His ice like crumbs; who can withstand His cold?

יח ישלח דברו וימסם ישב רוחו יזלו-מים:

18. He dispatches His word and melts them; He blows His wind, they flow as water.

יט מגיד דברו [דבריו] ליעקב חקיו ומשפטיו לישראל:

19. He declares His word to Jacob, His statutes and His laws to Israel.

כ לא עשה כן | לכל-גוי ומשפטים בל-ידעום הללויה:

20. He did not do so to any [other] nation; and of His laws they were not informed. Praise God.
