א לְדָוִד | שִׁפְטֵנִי ד' כִּי־אֲנִי בְּתִמְי הַלְכֹתִי וּבִדְבַר בְּטַחְתִּי לֹא אֶמְעָד:

1. Of David, [a Psalm]. Judge me, Adoniye, for in my wholeheartedness I have walked, and in Adoniye I have trusted, I will not waver.

ב בַּחֲנִנִי ד' וְנִסְנִי צְרוּפָה [צָרְפָה] כְּלִיֹּתִי וְלִבִּי:

2. Examine me, Adoniye, and test me, refine [purify] my mind and my heart.

ג כִּי־חֶסֶדְךָ לִנְגִיד עֵינַי וְהִתְהַלַּכְתִּי בְּאֱמֻנָתְךָ:

3. For Your kindness is before my eyes, and I have walked in your truth.

ד לֹא־יִשְׁבַּתִּי עִם־מְתֵי־שׂוֹא וְעִם־נְעֲלָמִים לֹא אָבוֹא:

4. I have not sat down with men of falsehood, and with those who sin in secret I do not associate.

ה שִׁנְאַתִּי קָהָל מְרַעִים וְעִם־רְשָׁעִים לֹא אֲשִׁב:

5. I have hated the gathering of evildoers, and with the wicked I will not sit.

ו אֶרְחֹץ בְּנִקְיוֹן כַּפַּי וְאֶסְבְּבָה אֶת־מִזְבִּיחֶךָ ד':

6. I will wash my hands in purity, and I will encircle Your altar, Adoniye.

ז לְשִׁמְעַ בְּקוֹל תוֹדָה וְלִסְפֹּר כָּל־נַפְלְאוֹתֶיךָ:

7. To make myself heard in a voice of thanksgiving and tell of all Your wonders.

ח ד' אֶהְבֵּתִי מְעוֹן בֵּיתְךָ וּמְקוֹם מְשׁוֹן כְּבוֹדְךָ:

8. Adoniye, I love the Dwelling, Your House, and the place where Your glory resides.

ט אַל־תִּאַסֹּף עִם־חַטָּאִים נַפְשִׁי וְעִם־אֲנָשֵׁי דָמִים חַיִּי:

9. Gather not my soul with sinners, nor my life with men of blood.

י אֲשֶׁר־בְּיַדֵּיהֶם זִמָּה וְיַמִּינָם מְלֶאֶה שָׁחַד:

10. For in their hands is mischief, and their right hand is full of bribes.

יא וְאֲנִי בְּתַמִּי אֵלֶיךָ פֹּדֵנִי וְחַנּוּנִי:

11. As for me, I will walk in my wholeheartedness; redeem me and favor me.

יב רַגְלִי עֲמֻדָה בְּמִישׁוֹר בְּמִקְהָלִים אֲבָרְךָ ד':

12. My foot stands on a straight path, in the congregations will I bless Adoniye.
