2. Adoniye is great and highly extolled in the city of our God, the mountains of His Sanctuary.

ג יִפֶּה נוֹף מְשׁוֹשׁ כָּל־הָאָרֶץ הַר־צִיּוֹן יִרְכָּתֵי צִפּוֹן קַרְיַת מֶלֶךְ רָב:

3. Beautiful in its panoramic vista, the joy of all the earth is Mount Zion, on the northern extremities (of Jerusalem); the city of the great King.

4. God, in its palaces, has become known as a Stronghold.

5. For behold, the kings assembled, they passed by together.

6. They saw and were astounded, they panicked and fled in haste.

may God establish it for eternity, Selah.

10. We hoped, God, for Your lovingkindness in the midst of Your Sanctuary.

יא כְּשֵׁםְךָ אֱלֹהִים כֵּן תִּהְלֶתְךָ עַל-קְצוֹי-אָרֶץ צְדָק מְלֵאָה יְמִינְךָ:

11. As Your Name, God, so is Your praise- to the ends of the earth; Your right
hand is full of righteousness.

יב יִשְׂמַח | הַר-צִיּוֹן תִּגְלַנָּה בָּנוֹת יְהוּדָה לְמַעַן מִשְׁפָּטֶיךָ:

12. Let Mount Zion rejoice, let the daughters of Judah exult, because of Your
judgments.

יג סִבּוּ צִיּוֹן וְהִקִּיפוּהָ סָפְרוּ מִגְדָּלֶיהָ:

13. Rally around Zion and encircle her, count her towers.
