2. How beloved are Your dwelling places, Adoniye of Hosts.

3. My soul yearns and even pines for the courtyards of Adoniye; my heart and my flesh will sing for joy to the living Almighty.

4. Even the bird has found a house, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she places her young on the ruins of Your Altars, Adoniye of Hosts, my King and my God.

10. Behold our shield [the temple] O' God and look upon the face of Your annointed.
