1. Sing to Adoniye a new song Sing to Adoniye all the [inhabitants of] earth.

ב שִׁירוּ לַד' בְּרַכּוּ שְׁמוֹ בְּשָׂרוֹ מִיּוֹם־לְיוֹם יְשׁוּעָתוֹ:

2. Sing to Adoniye, bless His name, proclaim His deliverance from day to day.

ג סַפְּרוּ בְּגוֹיִם כְּבוֹדוֹ בְּכָל־הָעַמִּים נִפְלְאוֹתָיו:

3. Recount His glory among the nations, His wonders among all the peoples.

ד כִּי גָדוֹל ד' וּמְהֻלָּל מְאֹד נֹרָא הוּא עַל־כָּל־אֱלֹהִים:

4. For Adoniye I great and most extolled; He is awesome above all Gods.

ה כִּי | כָּל־אֱלֹהֵי הָעַמִּים אֱלִילִים וְד' שָׁמַיִם עָשָׂה:

5. For all the gods of the nations are idols, whereas Adoniye made the heavens.

ו הוֹד־וְהֶדָּר לְפָנָיו עֹז וְתִפְאֶרֶת בְּמִקְדָּשׁוֹ:

6. Beauty and splendor are before Him, strength and glory are in His sanctuary.

ז הָבוּ לַד' מִשְׁפָּחוֹת עַמִּים הָבוּ לַד' כְּבוֹד וְעֹז:

7. Ascribe to Adoniye –families of peoples— ascribe to Adoniye honor and might!

ח הָבוּ לַד' כְּבוֹד שְׁמוֹ שְׂאוּ מִנְחָה וּבְאוּ לְחִצְרוֹתָיו:

8. Ascribe to Adoniye the honor due His Name, bring an offering and come to His courtyards.

ט הִשְׁתַּחֲוּוּ לַד' בְּהַדְרַת־קֹדֶשׁ חִילוֹ מִפְּנֵי כָּל־הָאָרֶץ:

9. Prostrate yourselves before Adoniye in the splendor of holiness; tremble before Him all (peoples of) the earth!

י אֲמַרוּ בְּגוֹלִים | ד' מֶלֶךְ אֶרֶץ־תְּכֹן תִּבֵּל בַּל־תִּמּוּט יִדִּין עַמִּים בְּמִישְׁרִים:

10. Declare among the nations, "Adoniye reigns!" for He established the world so that it cannot be moved, He will judge the peoples with uprightness.

יא יִשְׂמְחוּ הַשָּׁמַיִם וְתִגַּל הָאָרֶץ יִרְעַם הַיָּם וּמְלֵאוֹ:

11. The heavens will rejoice, the earth will exult, the sea and its fullness will roar.

יב יַעֲלֶז שָׂדֵי וְכָל־אֲשֶׁר־בּוֹ אִזְ יִרְנְנוּ כָּל־עֵצֵי־יַעַר:

12. The field and all that is in it will jubilate, then all the trees of the forest will sing for joy.

יג לִפְנֵי ד' | כִּי בָּא כִּי בָּא לְשֹׁפֵט הָאָרֶץ יִשְׁפֹּט־תִּבֵּל בְּצֶדֶק וְעַמִּים בְּאֱמוּנָתוֹ:

13. Before Adoniye when He comes—when He comes to judge the earth; He will judge mankind with justice, and peoples with His truth.
