4. Do they not know, all the workers of iniquity, who would devour My people as they devour bread, [and] unto Adoniye they call not?

5. There they were in great fear, for God is with the righteous generation.

**ו עַצְתַּעַנִי תְּבִישׁוּ כִּי ? ד' מִחְסָה:**

6. The counsel f the poor you would put to shame, that Adoniye is his refuge.
