א לְמַנְצֵחַ אֶל־תְּשֻׁחַת מִזְמוֹר לְאַסָּף שִׁיר:

1. To the Chief Musician, Al Tash-het, a Psalm of Asaph, a song.

ב הִוְדִינוּ לְךָ | אֱלֹקִים הוֹדִינוּ וְקָרֹב שְׁמֶךָ סִפְרוּ נִפְלְאוֹתֶיךָ:

2. We gave thanks to You, God, we gave thanks, for Your Name is near; they told of Your wonders.

ג כִּי־אֶקַח מוֹעֵד אֲנִי מִישָׁרִים אֲשַׁפֵּט:

3. When I celebrate the appointed Festival I will judge [its theme] with fairness.

ד נְמוּגִים־אָרְץ וְכָל־יֹשְׁבֵיהָ אֲנֹכִי תִכְנַתִּי עֲמוּדֶיהָ סֵלָה:

4. In danger of total dissolvment was the earth and all its inhabitants, but I firmly established its pillars, Selah.

ה אֶמְרֹתִי לְהוֹלִלִים אֶל־תִּהְיוּ לָו וְלִרְשָׁעִים אֶל־תִּרְיֹמוּ קָרוֹן:

5. I say to the arrogant, "deal not arrogantly"; and to the wicked,[I say] "do not raise the horn [of arrogance]."

ו אֶל־תִּרְיֹמוּ לַמָּרוֹם קַרְנֵכֶם תִּדְבְּרוּ בְצוּאָר עַתְק:

6. Raise not up heavenward, your horn, nor speak insolently with a haughty neck.

ז כִּי לֹא מִמּוֹצֵא וּמִמַּעֲרֵב וְלֹא מִמִּדְבָּר הָרִים:

7. For neither from the east nor from the west, nor from the wilderness [comes success.]

ח כִּי-אֱלֹקִים שֹׁפֵט זֶה יִשְׁפִּיל וְזֶה יָרִים:

8. For God is the judge, one He humbles, and one He raises.

ט כִּי כּוֹס בְּיַד-ד' וַיִּין חֲמֵר | מְלֵא מִסֶּךָ וַיִּגַּר מִזֶּה אֶדְ-שְׁמֶרְיָה יִמְצוּ יִשְׁתּוּ כָּל רְשָׁעֵי-אֶרֶץ:

9. For a cup is in the hand of Adoniye, with strong wine, a full mixture, and He pours out of this [cup]; [but] only it dregs will they drain and drink---all the wicked of the earth.

י וְאֲנִי אֲנִיד לְעַלְמֵ אֲזַמְרָה לְאֱלֹקֵי יַעֲקֹב:

10. But as for me, I will declare it forever, I will sing praises to the God of Jacob.

יא וְכָל-קַרְנֵי רְשָׁעִים אֲגַדֵּעַ תְּרוֹמְמָנָה קַרְנוֹת צְדִיק:

11. And all the horns [pride] of the wicked I will cut off, uplifted will be the pride of the righteous.
